BASIC PHONE FEATURES

Placing Calls

Using the handset:

or dial the number first, and then pick up Pick up the handset and dial the number the handset.

Using the speakerphone:

- With the handset on-hook, press:
- Any assigned line key, or
- The **New Call** soft key.
- Dial the number. Or dial the number. and then press the Dial soft key.

Using the optional headset:

- With the headset connected, press:
- Any assigned line key, or
- The **New Call** soft key.

During a call, you can alternate between handset, headset, or hands-free modes by pressing the Speakerphone or Headset keys or picking up the handset.

Answering Calls

Transfering Calls

To transfer a call:

- 1. During a call, press Transfer or the Trnsfr soft key. The active call is placed on hold.
- 2. Place a call to the party to which you To cancel the transfer before the call connects, press the **Cancel** soft key. The original call resumes. want to transfer the call.
- When you hear the ring-back sound or after you speak with the second party, or the **Trnsfr** soft key

soft key. Then complete step 2. After you complete step 1, press the **Blind** without speaking with the second party. You can automatically transfer the call

Forwarding Calls

To enable call forwarding:

- From the idle screen, press the Forward soft key.
- 2. Select the forwarding type you want to enable:
- Always—To forward all incoming
- No Answer—To forward all unanswered incoming calls.
- Enter a number to forward calls to. For No Answer, enter the number of rings **Busy**—To forward calls that arrive when you are already in a call.
- 4 Press the **Enable** soft key. before forwarding.

To disable call forwarding:

- 1. From the idle screen, press the Forward soft key
- Select the forwarding type you want to
- Press the **Disable** soft key
